



Regulations 49th Batavierenrace

Last modified: 17/04/2021

General Ranking

1. General

- 1.1. Teams that have registered for the General Ranking of the 49th Batavierenrace are subject to the preliminary regulations. When actually participating in the Batavians Race these teams are also subject to these final regulations.
- 1.2. The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the Regulations if necessary.
- 1.3. The Dutch version of the Regulations is leading in all cases.

2. Registration

- 2.1. Registration is possible from Saturday, February 13, 2021 12:00.
- 2.2. Registration can be done by filling out the Google Form, found on the website.
- 2.3. There is a maximum of 25 participants per team. There is no minimum.
- 2.4. Registration is possible until Wednesday, March 17, 2021 23:59. The registered time in the Google Form will be used as starting point.

3. Stages

- 3.1. A team must have covered at least 125 km. All individual stages must therefore add up to at least 125 km.
- 3.2. For each missing kilometer, 12 minutes of penalty time will be added.
- 3.3. Running more kilometers than the minimum is allowed.
- 3.4. Each participant will run 1 stage. There is no limit on the distance of this stage.
- 3.5. Elevation differences or paved/unpaved roads during walked stages will not be taken into account in the final results.
- 3.6. There are no specific men's or women's stages as normally during the Batavierenrace.
- 3.7. A stage must be run in one piece. It is not allowed to split up the stage of a participant.
- 3.8. Runners may run their stage between Thursday, April 22, 2021 16:30 and Saturday, April 24, 2021 17:30.

4. Submission of results

- 4.1. Participants can submit the result of their stage individually via the website of the Online Batavierenrace which is communicated to the team leaders. The submission requires a team code which the team leader receives together with the link to the website and shares with the team members.
- 4.2. For each participant the run distance, the date, the elapsed time, and the name of the participant must be submitted.
- 4.3. Also, for confirmation, an image showing the distance run, date, time elapsed, participant name and route run must be submitted. Taking a screenshot of the run in a running app like Strava is enough for this. Please note that not only the moved time is visible. Elapsed time becomes visible on the overview by marking the stage as a race.
- 4.4. Other tracking programs than Strava are also allowed provided they display all the above data. This should be checked in advance.
- 4.5. Results must be submitted via the aforementioned website by Saturday, April 24, 2021 17:30 at the latest.
- 4.6. If the submitted result of a stage (the data or accompanying screenshot) or the stage itself does not comply with the rules under this heading or heading 3, the result of that stage or the entire stage will be rejected and will not be included in the provisional results. The team leader will be notified and will be given a one-time opportunity to resubmit the missing results and/or stages via email to online@batavierenrace.nl before Sunday, April 25, 2021 23:59.



5. *Registration fee and deregistration*

- 5.1. The registration fee is €30 per team.
- 5.2. The entry fee must be paid via the invoice sent to the team leader on April 12, 2021.
- 5.3. The registration fee must be paid before April 26, 2021 23:59. If the registration fee is not paid by this deadline, the participation of the team will be cancelled.
- 5.4. In case of deregistration, the team leader must notify the Organizing Committee by sending an email to online@batavierenrace.nl.

6. *Layout of the race*

- 6.1. The race will be supported by a live radio and video broadcast to be followed via Vimeo, to be found on the Batavierenrace website.
- 6.2. On Saturday, April 24, 2021, a preliminary awards ceremony will be held around 20:30 via the live stream.
- 6.3. The results will be compiled per classification based on the speed, calculated based on the total elapsed time and total run distance. If a team did not achieve the minimum distance, their run distance will be increased to the minimum distance for the classification and a penalty time of 12 minutes per missing kilometer will be added to their total time.
- 6.4. Teams may file protests against the preliminary results via email to online@batavierenrace.nl from Saturday, April 24, 2021 21:00 to Tuesday, April 27, 2021 23:59.
- 6.5. The final results will be announced Wednesday, April 28, 2021.
- 6.6. In the event of a tie based on equal speed, the team with the most kilometres run in total will take precedence.

7. *COVID-19*

- 7.1. Participants must keep 1.5m distance from other people at all times while running their stage.
- 7.2. Participants may, in accordance with current measures, run a stage with a maximum of 2 people. This means that more than two team members may not run the same route at the same times.
- 7.3. During the normal Batavierenrace it is customary for a cyclist to ride with the runner as a navigator or for encouragement. This is also possible during the Online Batavierenrace. Take in mind the rule of maximum two people together.
- 7.4. To respect the ban on gathering from the government, it is not allowed to come together with more than 2 participants. With 2 or less participants, a distance of 1.5 m must be kept at all times in public. This rule also applies to things like encouragement, taking (group) photographs, etc.
- 7.5. The regulations regarding COVID-19 from the government are leading at all times.
- 7.6. If a participant does not comply with the rules under this heading, this participant and his team will be disqualified from participating in the 49th Batavierenrace.

University Competition (UC)

The rules below are in addition to the general rules.

8. *General*

- 8.1. Teams that have registered for the University Competition of the 49th Batavians Race are subject to the preliminary regulations. When actually participating in the Batavians Race these teams are also subject to these final regulations.
- 8.2. The University Competition is a separate classification, the University Ranking, in which each Dutch university and/or college of higher education can delegate the fastest possible team.
- 8.3. Teams participating in the University Competition are called university teams.
- 8.4. Names of university teams must begin with the short names of the institutions involved.
- 8.5. A maximum of one university team may participate per umbrella student sports body. Similarly, only one university team may participate per educational institution. Multiple educational institutions may participate together with one university team.
- 8.6. All runners of university teams must meet the requirements set by Student Sport Netherlands (SSN) at the opening of registrations for participants in NSKs. Therefore, runners of university teams must be or have been full-time students at one of the institutions involved in their university team in the



2019-2020 or 2020-2021 academic year, and must be at least 16 and no more than 30 years old on the date of the race.

9. *Registration and participation*

- 9.1. Registration can be done by emailing the following information to secretaris@batavierenrace.nl: team name, team leader name, and from 3 runners a valid proof of registration at the college or university for which the team competes.
- 9.2. Registration is possible until Wednesday, March 17, 2021 23:59. The moment the organization receives the registration email is taken as the starting point.
- 9.3. A team must submit proof of registration from the relevant educational institution for each runner they wish to register before April 4, 2021 23:59. So including reserves. This does not yet have to be a final indication of runners.
- 9.4. There is no limit for reserves.
- 9.5. The following may be considered as valid evidence (dating from college year 2019-2020 or 2020-2021): proof of registration, college card with year, proof of graduation with official stamp of the institution, proof of deregistration with official stamp of the institution.
- 9.6. The final list of runners must be submitted by April 18, 2021 23:59.
- 9.7. A team must consist of 25 participants.
- 9.8. Should a runner from the final list get injured in the days shortly before the Batavierenrace, contact should be made as soon as possible with secretaris@batavierenrace.nl
- 9.9. The team leader is responsible for the team, who is not necessarily a participant himself. The team leader is responsible for finding team members.

10. *Stages*

- 10.1. A UC team must have completed a minimum of 175 km.
- 10.2. The total 175 km must be divided into 16 stages run by men and 9 stages run by ladies. The team will therefore consist of 16 men and 9 women.
- 10.3. For each additional man (>16) a penalty time of 5 minutes will be charged.
- 10.4. UC runners are required to publish their stage in Strava and make it public for verification.
